You will continue to receive your spellings, reading, times tables, English and Maths homework.

Create a menu for a Greek feast.	Read about Narcissus, and write a letter to tell him to change his ways.	Over a week, do some exercise each day. Record your exercise and time. Can you beat your P.B.?
Build a Greek Temple, you could use: plastercine, junk modelling etc...	Design and create a family shield.	Make a bubble map of a Greek God, explaining their super power and characteristics.
Create a fact file on a Greek philosopher. Such as Plato, Aristotle or Archimedes.	Research a Ancient Greek war and write a newspaper article about it or draw a timeline of events.	Create your own homework activity, based on any aspect of your Greek learning.
