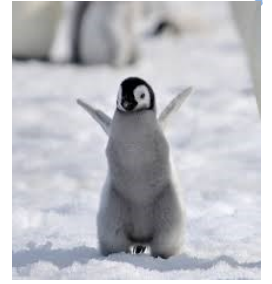


Frozen Kingdom Homework

Show features and materials.</p>
